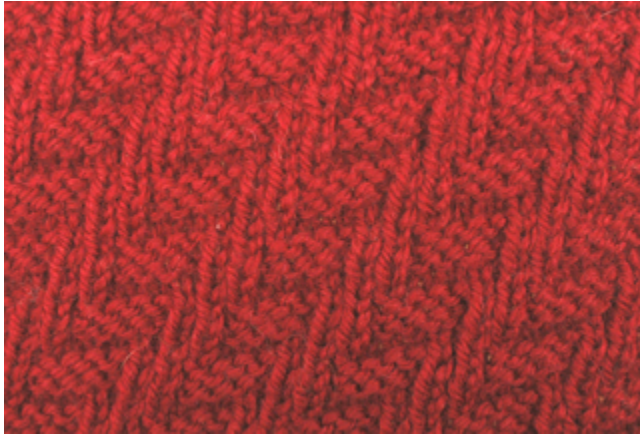


Knit Scarf for Red Scarf Project



This pattern is absolutely free, but please consider making a version for the Orphan Foundation of America (<http://orphan.org/>) if you make one for yourself or as a gift.

Yarn: Plymouth's Encore Worsted 75% Acrylic, 25% Wool, 2 skeins

Needles: #7

Size: 6" wide and 60" long

Gauge: 6.7 stitches to the inch in Rib and Welt Diagonals

Stitch Pattern (Rib and Welt Diagonals from Barbara Walker's A Second Treasury of Knitting Patterns)

row 1: * k1, p1, k1, p5 *; repeat from *

row 2 and all other even-numbered rows - knit all knits and purl all purls as they appear.

row 3: k1, p1, * k5, p1, k1, p1; repeat from * to the last 6 stitches, then k5, p1.

row 5: k1, * p5, k1, p1, k1; repeat from * to the last 7 stitches, then p5, k1, p1.

row 7: * k5, p1, k1, p1 *, repeat from *

row 9: p4, * k1, p1, k1, p5; repeat from * to the last 4 stitches, then (k1, p1) twice.

row 11: k3, *p1, k1, p1, k5; repeat from * to the last 5 stitches, then p1, k1, p1, k2.

row 13: p2, * k1, p1, k1, p5: repeat from * to the last 6 stitches, then k1, p1, k1, p3.

row 15: k1, *p1, k1, p1, k5; repate from * to the last 7 stitches, then p1, k1, p1, k4.

row 16: Knit all knits and purl all purls as they appear.

Tips: This pattern IS simple to work, but, if you lose your way, remember that the small horizontal bars in the fabric are only ever 2 rows deep. If you find you are still having trouble, copy the directions out onto index cards, and flip through your deck as you go. I also like to place a marker on the odd-rowed side, so I know that is the side when I'm not just following the knits and purls from the row before. Also, no matter what the above instructions say, I always slip the first stitch.

Cast on 40 stitches. Work in Rib and Welt Diagonals until the piece is 60" long. Cast off.

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
