

Santa Hat Ornament

Needles: #4 needles, whatever type you prefer to create a small-diameter round piece.

Yarn: Patons Lace Sequin,
1 skein each Ruby and Crystal

Gauge: 6 stitches to the inch

Notions: One 10.5-inch clear glass ornament

3 stitch markers

1 white pom-pom or pom-pom maker

Cast on 63 stitches in white, join to knit in the round. Place a marker for the beginning of the round. Work (purl all stitches around, knit all stitches around) twice. Knit every stitch for 3 more rounds.

Switch to red yarn. Knit 7 rounds in red. Place a marker 21 stitches from the beginning of the round, and another one 42 stitches away from the beginning of the round.

Decrease Section

Round 1: [Knit to 2 stitches from the marker, k2t.] Repeat this 3 times for the round.

Round 2: Knit every stitch.



Repeat these two rounds until you have 3 stitches left. Break yarn and draw through the last 3 stitches. Tuck end into the inside of the hat. Make pom-pom with white yarn or attach pre-made white pom-pom to the top of the hat.

Darn in all ends. Fit hat over clear glass ornament. Flop hat over, then thread string for ornament through fabric of hat.

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
